### Book 22 (contd.)

**Content** The book was started in January 1920 and the title page carefully inscribed 'China Patterns to be used only for Special decorations numbers commencing at 2000 starting at page 200'. Space on the subsequent pages was left for an alphabetical index of customers but only the first two patterns were completed here, the space was then used to write in numbers below 100. Once the sequence starting at 100 reached 246, a decision was made to renumber patterns 246-249 (with some variations) as 50-56, but there is no sign that any other numbers below 100 were ever allocated to patterns. Also, in this space is a list of 'Gem' vases and at the end of the book is a list of 'Nursey finishes'. Seconds patterns were later rebound separately into book 24.
